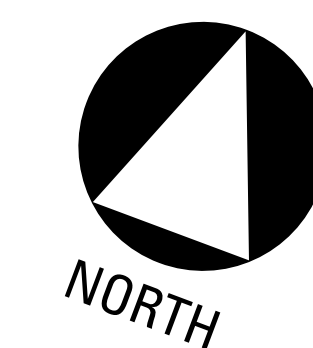
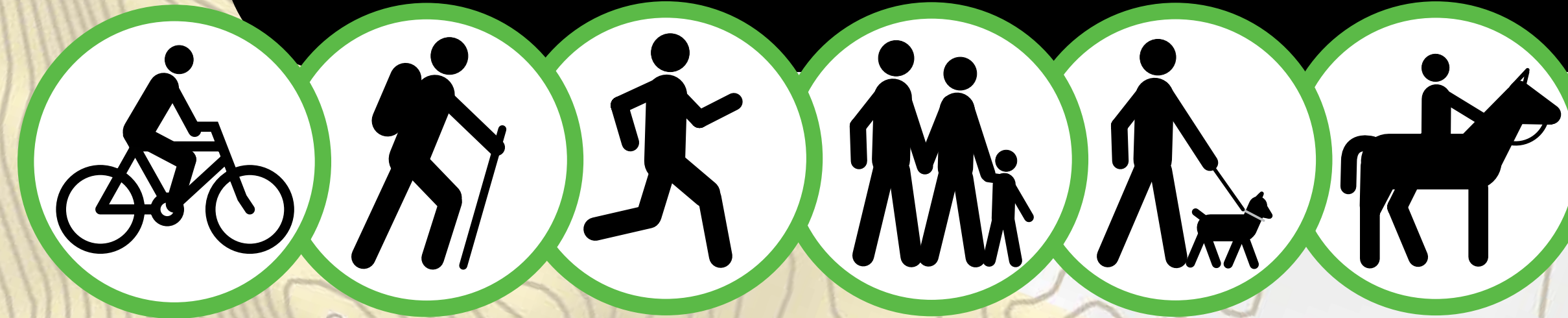


BV AREA TRAILS

BV Area Trails is a nonmotorized singletrack system. All trails are above 8000,' with frequent short steep up and downs, and sections of unexpected technical difficulty. Be alert!

Although most trails are open to hikers, runners and mountainbikers, the rating system focuses on mountainbiking skill levels. Hikers and runners will find trail ratings useful as general guidelines.
